

**Resolution No. 505/2014
of the Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd.**

The Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd. (hereinafter: Exchange) **removes the registered closed-end investment units** (ISIN: HU0000711361) named **K&H Olimpia Plusz Derivative Closed-End Securities Investment Fund issued by K&H Olimpia Plusz Derivative Closed-End Securities Investment Fund** (represented by K&H Investment Fund Management Private Limited Company /1095 Budapest, Lechner Ödön fasor 9./, hereinafter: Issuer) from the Product List as from **November 14, 2014**.

The Last Day of Trading for the investment units is **November 12, 2014**.

The Issuer may appeal against this decision within 15 Exchange Days from the date of receipt. The appeal must be addressed to the Board of Directors and submitted to the Chief Executive Officer of the Exchange.
