



## Extract from Resolution No. 2/2017 of the Conciliation Committee

Budapest, June 23, 2017

Upon authorization by Section 36 of the Book Five of the “General Terms of Service of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd.” titled Regulations on Trading (hereinafter: Regulations on Trading), the Conciliation Committee passes the following decision on single equity based BMW, BNP Paribas, Commerzbank, Daimler, Deutsche Bank, EON, Thyssenkrupp and Total futures contracts.

Upon authorization by Section 36.2 of the Regulations on Trading, the Conciliation Committee sets June 30, 2017 as the Last Trading Day in certain maturities of the above futures contracts.

Considering the stipulation contained in Section 32.2.b) of the Book Two of the “General Terms of Service of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd” titled Regulations on Listing and Continued Trading, the Conciliation Committee sets July 4, 2017 as the day of removing the above contracts from the Product List.

Positions remaining open on June 30, 2017 will be settled by cash settlement, basically at end-of-day settlement prices set for the different maturities on June 30, 2017, which the Conciliation Committee will publish in an announcement following the closing of the day. If the Conciliation Committee detects transactions of manipulative intention on the last day of trading, which divert end-of-day settlement prices, then it will determine and publish final settlement prices by disregarding those deals.
