

MASTERPLAST Nyilvánosan Működő Részvénytársaság (registered office: 8143 Sárszentmihály, Árpád u. 1/A.; hereinafter: the "Company" or "MASTERPLAST Nyrt.") hereby informs the honourable Investors that the European Commission has initiated an investigation under case R866 concerning the possible circumvention of the anti-dumping measures applicable to imports of open mesh fabrics ("OMF") originating in the People's Republic of China. The investigation covers Serbia and, consequently, the Serbian subsidiary of MASTERPLAST Nyrt.

Investigations of this nature form part of the European Union's established trade defence procedures, and the initiation of such an investigation does not in itself constitute a finding of any infringement.

The Company is fully cooperating with the European Commission in the course of the investigation and is confident that its manufacturing activities in Serbia comply with the applicable requirements.

MASTERPLAST Nyrt. expects that the investigation may contribute to a more transparent European fiberglass mesh market and to strengthening fair competition, which could be beneficial for the Company in the longer term.
